## Requirements for membership in Nico Wynd Men's Golf Club

Unless otherwise indicated, all Club Play is in accordance with the Rules of Golf. It is the players' responsibility to know and apply these Rules. .

Two basic premises underlie the *Handicap System*

- Each player will try to make the best score at every hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played.
  - The player will post every \*acceptable round for Handicap Committee/peer review.
- Fair handicapping depends upon full and accurate information regarding a player's potential scoring ability as reflected by a complete scoring record. Every player must be responsible for posting all acceptable scores.

### \*Acceptable Rounds

- Scores must be made in accordance with the Rules of Golf
- Adjusted gross scores (applying ESC as below) from all courses with Course and Slope Ratings, or equivalent, at home, away or out of country.
- If 13 or more holes are played, the player shall post an 18-hole score. If 7 to 12 holes are played, the player shall post a 9-hole score
- Scores in both match play and stroke play shall be posted even if some holes are not completed due to "gimmies" or pick-ups.

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) or Adjusted Gross Score, must be applied to all scores – i.e.:

9 or Less Course Handicap	Maximum of 2 over par
10-19 Course Handicap	Maximum score of 7
20-29 Course Handicap	Maximum score of 8
30-39 Course Handicap	Maximum score of 9
40 and Over Course Handicap	Maximum score of 10
